

AN ORDINANCE FOR LAYING OUT AND OPENING A STREET OVER AND ACROSS THE LANDS OF EVA WUETHRICH AND ALBERT WUETHRICH IN THE VILLAGE OF PLATO.

Whereas, the Village Council of the Village of Plato did, on the 13th day of October 1899 declare their purpose by resolution duly passed to take all of the following described lands and premises, situated in said Village of Plato to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the section line between section 11 and 14 of township 115 range 27, in McLeod County Minnesota 870 ft west of the southeast corner of said section (11) eleven thence south 44 degrees and 20 minutes west 90 feet thence south 61 degrees and 20 minutes west 283 feet to the west line of the lands of Eva Wuethrich and Albert Wuethrich and containing 563 -1000 of an acre for a public highway and street and did by said resolution fix the 23rd day of October 1899 at 9 o'clock in the forenoon of said day at Schulle's Hall in said Village of Plato as the time and place when and where they would apply William Torrey, one of the Village Justice of the Peace of said Village, for a jury to condemn and appraise the lands above described for said purpose; and whereas at the time and place designated in and by said resolution they did make such application to said Justice of the Peace for a jury aforesaid a notice of such application having been theretofore duly given to the owners of the lands over which such highway and street were to pass, and such jury was duly selected and summoned and did appear at the time and place appointed for such hearing and did personally examine the lands and premises to be taken for such highway and street and did hear the evidence adduced them in regard to the same and did bring in their verdict in writing signed by each of them wherein and where by they did find it necessary to take the lands and premises above described for the purpose aforesaid and did by another and separate verdict at the same time and place assess the damages sustained by said Eva Wuethrich and Albert Wuethrich, by reason of the laying out of said street and highway at the sum of one hundred dollars which verdict was in writing and signed by each of said jurors; and so hereas the said Village Justice of the Peace has filed in the office of the Village Recorder of said Village of Plato all of the original papers together with the said verdicts of said jury, annexed together with a transcript of his docket containing all of the proceedings had said matter and his certificate that said papers were such original papers and that said transcript from his said docket of all proceedings had in such matter and whereas the time has expired for appealing from said verdict and said order and no person has appealed therefrom:

Now therefore the Village Council of the Village of Plato do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a public street and highway four rods wide of wide of which the following described line shall be the center line, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the section line between section 11 and 14 in Township 115 range 27 in McLeod County Minnesota 870 feet west of the southeast corner of said section 11, thence south 44 degrees and 20 minutes west 90 feet, thence south 61 degrees and 20 minutes west 283 feet to the west line of the premises of Eva Wuethrich and Albert Wuethrich, be laid out and opened over and across the lands of the said Eva Wuethrich and Albert Wuethrich and that the sum of one hundred dollars being the amount awarded to the said Wuethrichs by the said verdict, as damages for taking of said lands for said purposes be and hereby is set apart for them in the hands of the treasurer of said village and that an order upon said treasure therefore be made out and deposited with the Village Recorder of said village for the said Wuethrichs there to remain subject to the order of said Wuethrichs.
