## ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 31 REGULATING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR AND NONINTOXICATING MALT LIQUOR AND PROVIDING FOR ABSOLUTE CLOSING HOURS

The City Council of the City of Plato ordains:

Section 1. There hereby is added the following provisions to Section 12  $\overline{\text{of Ordinance No. 31}}$ :

"No person shall permit any person, who is not the owner of a bonofide employee of the licensed establishment to loiter or remain upon the licenses premises at any time later than one half hour after closing hours as set forth by State law, and in any event, no person shall consume any intoxicating beverage or nonintoxicating malt liquor upon any licensed premises later than one-half hour after said closing hours. It shall be unlawful for any licensee to use or permit to be used the licensed premises by any person for any purpose other than normal sanitation purposes, restocking of supplies and equipment, accounting procedures, repairs and remodeling, or functions incident thereto from and after one-half hour after the closing hours as set by State Statute until the following lawful hours for which establishment is permitted to open."

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
