

## ORDINANCE NO. 48

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SEWER FUND FOR THE CITY OF PLATO AND TO IMPOSE  
A SEWER CHARGE UPON ALL PREMISES WITHIN THE CITY OF PLATO

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATO ORDAINS:

Section 1: There is hereby established a sewer fund for the City of Plato which shall be maintained as a separate part of the general fund and for which all income into said fund shall be segregated from other City funds. Books and records shall be maintained separately for all income and expenditures from said fund. Said fund is established for the express purpose of providing funds for the construction, maintenance, repair and replacement of the sanitary and/or storm sewer system and lines within the City of Plato and matters related thereto.

Section 2: There is hereby imposed upon each premises in the City of Plato which is connected to the City of Plato municipal water supply a sewer charge. This sewer charge is initially established at ten percent (10%) of the water charge billed for any particular quarter. The City Council shall have the power to modify the sewer charge so established from time to time by resolution.

Section 3: The sewer charge so established shall be collected with the regular water bills as a separate item and all collections so made shall be deposited in the sewer fund. Any unpaid bills shall be collected and enforced in the same manner as water bills are collected or enforced.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
