

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SNOWMOBILES, REGULATING THE OPERATION AND USE THEREOF, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Village Council of the Village of Plato ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a snowmobile under the following circumstances:

- A. On private property of another without express permission to do so by the owner or occupant of said property;
- B. On public school grounds, park property, play grounds, recreation acres, without the express permission to do so by the proper public authority;
- C. In a manner so as to create loud, unnecessary noise so as to disturb or interfere with the peace and quiet of other persons;
- D. In a careless, reckless or negligent manner so as to endanger the safety of any person or the property of any other person;
- E. To operate a snowmobile at a speed in excess of ten (10) miles per hour within the Village of Plato;
- F. To operate a snowmobile in the Village of Plato between the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and 12:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday;
- G. Prohibit the operations of snowmobiles on Main Street, beginning at County Road No. 9 then east and south to US Highway 212.

Section 2. Any persons violating the terms of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined a sum not to exceed \$100.00 or shall be imprisoned for a period not to exceed 90 days.
