

## ORDINANCE NO 51

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TERMS FOR THE MAYOR IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAWS OF 1994 CHAPTER 646

WHEREAS, the laws of 1994 Chapter 646 permit the City to establish the terms for mayor at four years, and

The City Council of the City of Plato ordains:

**Section 1.** The term for the mayor is hereby established at four years.

**Section 2.** There shall be a city election for electing the mayor on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of every other even numbered year, or such other day as may be established by state statute for state wide general elections.

**Section 3.** The mayor shall be elected at the city election to be held in November, 1998, to a four year term commencing January, 1999.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
